



CREMS v5.02 update – what's new

Items that have been addressed/updated in the new CReMS 5.02 release

- Where users update reviewer details, these details will now be saved and update in the CReMS "Summary" screen and also appear in any exported documents. Once updated fields in CReMS will remain populated with the reviewer details.
- The output of author names is formatted the same in both the protocol and report.
- Correction of issue arising "silent or hidden" characters that were interfering with export of .rtf file and resulted in a blank file being exported.
- Where there is no internet connection SUMARI offline mode now allows the user to immediately select their latest locally saved version of the review to continue their work.
- The "date" field of the review (Summary page) can now be changed.
- The numbering output style (superscript) in exported protocols and reviews now complies with Vancouver output format. The output format of the protocol reference list also complies with Vancouver format.
- Text entered into the "acknowledgements" field in the protocol now appears in the exported document.
- Multiple warnings no longer appear after clicking in a "blocked" field of either the protocol or report builder.
- Text from the protocol appears in the appropriate sections of the "Report Builder" in an unmodifiable, "blocked" field, prior to transfer of the protocol to the report.
- The CReMS logo window now remains on the screen when the software is launched and a CReMS button now appears in the windows task bar at the bottom of the screen.
- Instability between the CReMS system and the online analytical modules that resulted in instances of data loss has now been rectified.
